and throughout the next several years, the JCC will be taking steps to enhance our facility for our members and reduce our consumption of valuable resources, becoming more efficient operationally, economically and environmentally.

While continuing to produce stellar programs and services here at the Katz JCC, we have begun to make much needed improvements to our infrastructure with the addition of new equipment and building repairs all while meeting our financial

obligations. We'll continue to look for more ways to update our building and conserve our natural resources as time goes on.

#### OUR SUSTAINABILITY PROJECT INCLUDES

**Energy Efficient Heating and Cooling System -** We are strategically replacing 24 aging air conditioning units with more efficient technology.

**Solar Panels & Roofing -** We are going to install solar panels on our roof. Before that can begin, we need to repair parts of the roof that have become worn and weak.

**Energy Efficient Lighting -** We are replacing our lighting with light bulbs that are more energy efficient.

**Pool Pump System -** Our new pool pump system is more efficient and we will be utilizing a more efficient temperature control.

**Bike Rack Installation -**Installing more bike racks not only encourages exercise but also decreases fossil fuel consumption and air pollution.


Food Waste Reduction - We consciously tried to reduce

food waste in our camp lunch program with better portion control and educated campers about waste reduction.

Natural Cleaning Supply Usage -We have been more conscious of the cleaning supplies we are using and have converted to more non-toxic cleaning products.

**Recycling** - By increasing the amount of recycling cans throughout the building and educating our campers, our recycling pickup has increased and trash pickup has decreased.

With these few changes we are making, we feel that we can say we are doing our part in making positive environmental changes. THE END OF JEWISH-**OWNED BUSINESSES IN NAZI BERLIN EXHIBITION** 

#### November 1 - 18

#### FREE AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

Temporary exhibition offering a detailed portrait of many of the thousands of Jewishowned businesses that were closed or taken over by non-Jewish Germans after the Nazis took power in Germany in 1933. The focus on a limited number of companies of varying sizes and economic branches is revealing in many ways. Clearly, Jewish businesses were a vibrant and diverse part of the general German economy before the Third Reich. Once the Nazis took power, the pressure to sell or emigrate, including legal persecution became stronger over time, and impossible to resist after Kristallnacht on November 9-10. 1938. Eventually, all Jewish businesses were closed, soldusually at far below their actual value-or taken over by non-Jews. Many of the owners were able to emigrate, but others became victims of the Nazi camps. By viewing this history of discrimination and state-sanctioned theft of private property, attendees will gain a better understanding of the ways that civil society and human decency could be subverted in a short period of time.
